# Hardrock Centre Rules



- All participants must complete an Agreement Form.
- All new visitors to this centre must complete a Safety Instruction and assessment prior to using Hardrock facilities.
- Lead climbing and belaying are restricted (see Lead Climbing Rules).
  
- Children under the age of 11 are not permitted to belay.
- The 5-Step Belay method is the only method to be used while belaying in this centre.
- The use of personal belay devices on top-ropes is not permitted.
- Belaying requires your undivided attention; use of mobile phones or cameras is not permitted while belaying.
- No lying or sitting down while belaying.
  
- No un-roped climbing. Traversing is permitted, however the climber's feet must not move above the lowest footholds available.
- Climbing shoes must be worn while climbing.
- Whilst climbing racing is not permitted.
- While top-rope climbing, the climber must be connected by the dual attachment of a locking karabiner and a re-threaded figure-of-eight knot.
- Mobile phones, cameras or other electronic devices are not to be carried while climbing.
- Children under the age of 15 are not permitted to boulder unless under the guidance of a Hardrock Instructor.
- Groups are not permitted to boulder unless it has been specifically organised prior to the activity.
- Whilst bouldering spotting is recommended.
  
- All hire equipment must be returned otherwise current replacement costs apply.
- Personal safety equipment must meet current UIAA standards.
- Management reserves the right to refuse the use of personal safety equipment.
- Whillan's, tree lopper, riggers or any homemade harnesses are not permitted.
- When using a personal climbing harness, the locking karabiner must be attached via the belay loop (where present), while the knot must be attached via the double-tie in point in the harness.
  
- No running in the centre.
- Loose chalk is not permitted; chalk must be in a chalk-ball in a chalk-bag.
- Appropriate clothing must be worn at all times, including full length singlets or t-shirts.
- Parents and group leaders are responsible for the behaviour of their children and any children in their care.
- Food or drink is not to be consumed in the climbing area.
- Chewing gum is not permitted.
- Hardrock does not take responsibility for personal belongings left in the centre, lockers are available for hire. Bags or personal belongings are not to be left in the climbing area.
- Smoking is not permitted on the premises. All hire equipment must be removed prior to smoking. Please dispose of cigarette butts thoughtfully.
- Participants must not be under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- Due to the Privacy Act - no photos or video recordings are to be taken unless permission has been granted by Hardrock Management.
- Refunds - please see Refunds Policy.

**Failure to comply with Hardrock Centre Rules as stated above may result in Management asking you to leave the premises. Management reserves the right to refuse entry.**
