Lead Harnesses Permitted at Hardrock

Harnesses must be EN12277 - Type C certified

Additionally, harnesses must:

- Have a dual tie-in point
- Have a separate **belay loop**
- Fit the participant correctly (as per manufacturer instructions)
- Be in a safe condition (refer to manufacturer instructions for inspection advice)
- Be less than 15 years old (or the within lifespan stipulated by the manufacturer; if this is less than 15 years)

Lead harnesses are **not** available for rental

Lead Belay Devices Permitted at Hardrock

The only permitted device is: **Black Diamond ATC Pilot** (As of 15th November 2018)

Additionally, the device must Be in a safe condition (refer to manufacturer instructions for inspection advice)



Lead belay devices are available for loan, free-of-charge (security deposit may apply)

Lead Ropes Permitted at Hardrock

Only EN892 ① ('single' dynamic) Ropes are permitted

Additionally the rope must be:

- ≥40 metres in length
- 8.7-10.5mm in diameter (recommended min. 9.5mm)
- In a safe condition (refer to manufacturer instructions for inspection advice)
- Less than 12 years old

(or the within lifespan stipulated by the manufacturer; if less than 12 years)

Lead ropes are **not** available for rental

Karabiners for Lead Belaying Permitted at Hardrock

Karabiners must be EN 12275 'Type H' (HMS) Certified

Additionally the karabiner must:

- Have a gate mechanism which requires 2 or more actions to open
- Have geometry which allows the BD ATC Pilot to move up and down freely
- Be in a safe condition (refer to manufacturer instructions for inspection advice)
